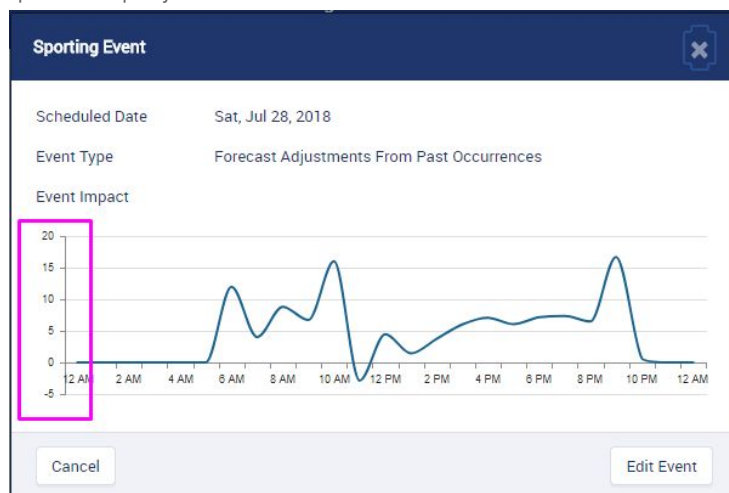

### 1. Business Challenge or Problem

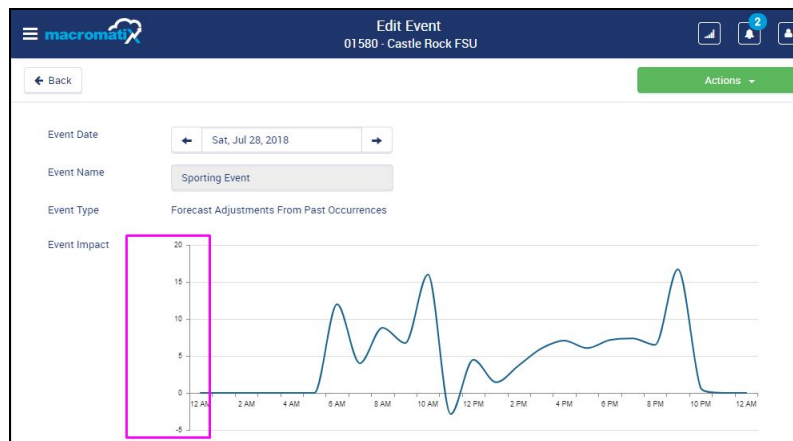

2. Calendar Day View

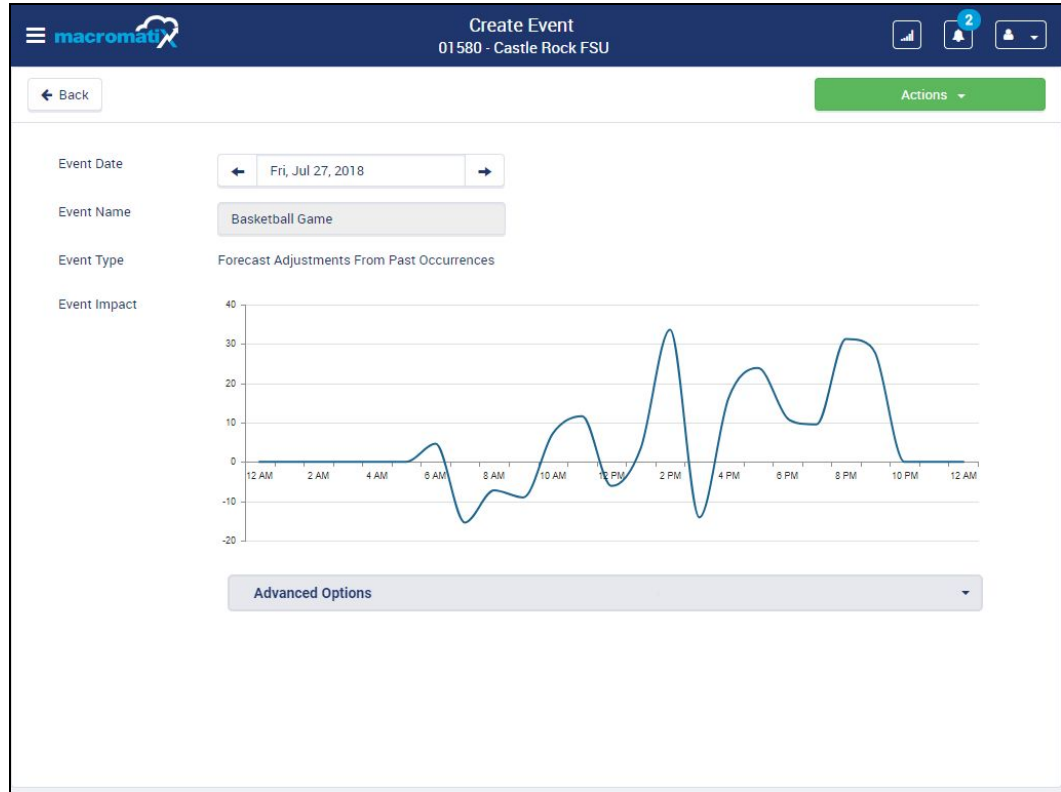
- a. A change was made to start the day view at 5am

start at 5am?

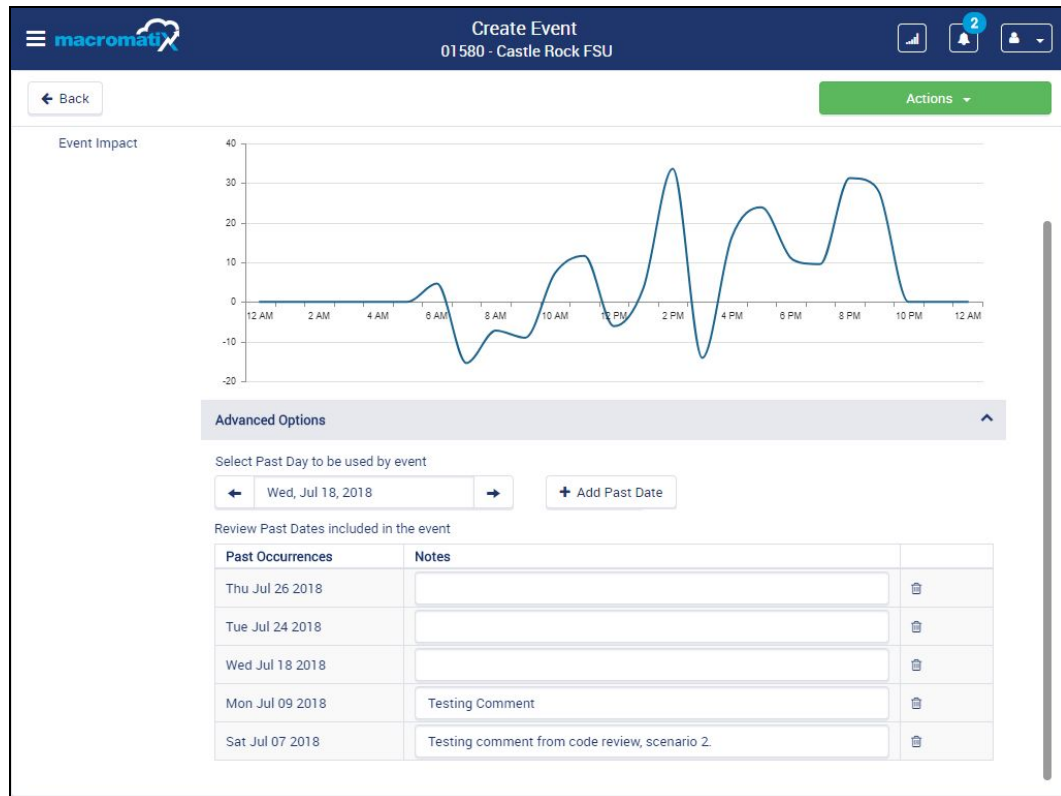
- c. The concern is that if for some reason the store were to configure an Event for the Late Night period (00:00 - 05:00), that event would not be displayed

- b. Accordion the day/date selection into an Advanced Options section that is collapsed by default:



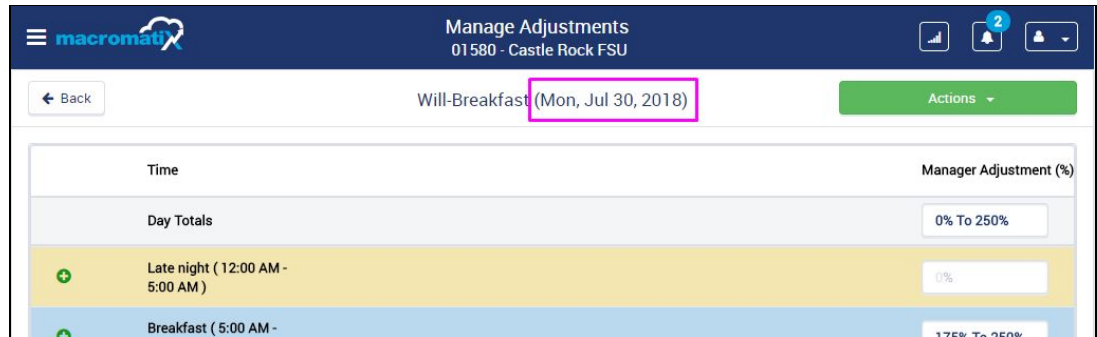

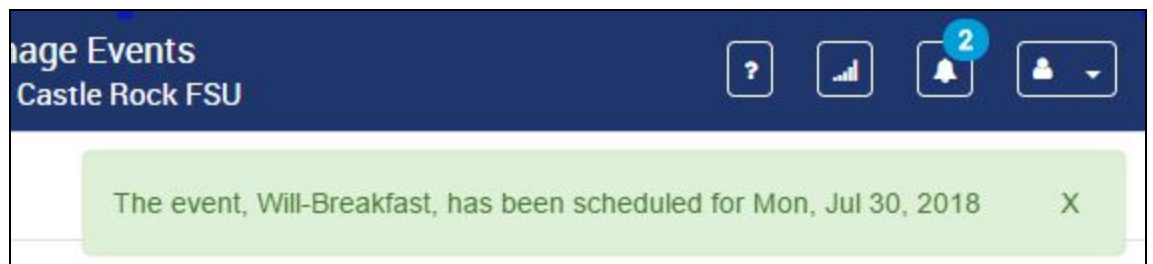

e. Selection of past dates

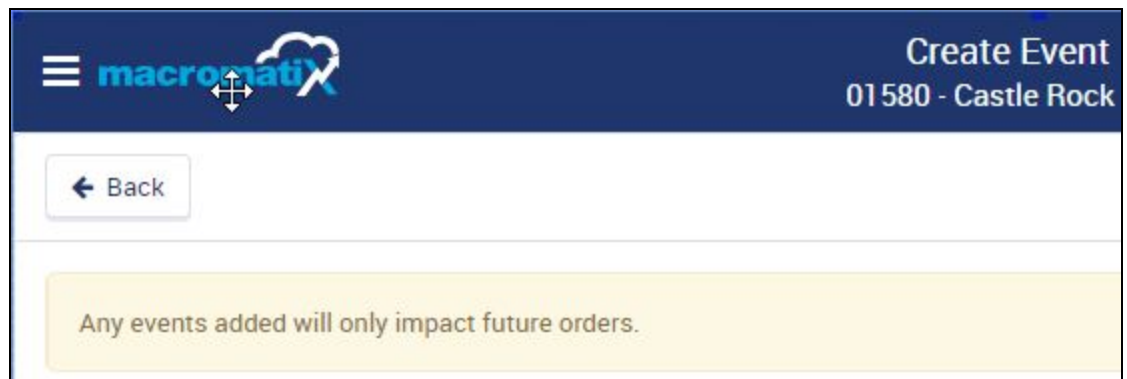
- i. Prevent the selection of Sundays

  - a. Include the scheduled date alongside the event name in the header



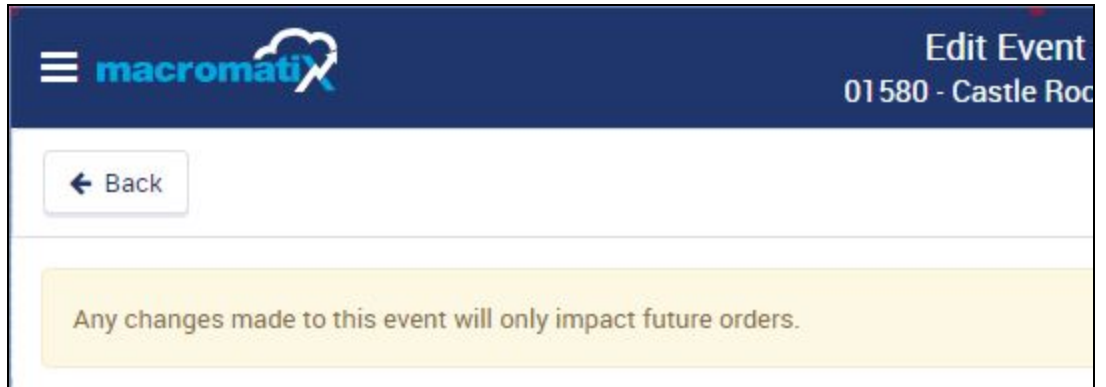
